Our offices are based in 117 Beach St in Fremantle / Walyalup overlooking the Derbal Yerrigan (Swan River). Our building hosts a 7 x 8m gallery and a 4.5 x 5m workshop space.

## **Artist Residency Expression of Interest**

Visual, performing, and community artists are invited to apply for self-driven development of work resulting in a public presentation or exhibition outcome.

Previous ART ON THE MOVE artists in residence include Whiskey & Boots, Melissa Cantwell & Kabuki Drop, Ross Potter, Lia Mcknight, Jarrad Martyn and Chloe Bartram.

The space is provided free of charge.

## Assessment

Applications will be assessed by the ART ON THE MOVE team based on the following criteria:

- Artistic merit;
- Potential to engage local audiences;
- Alignment with ART ON THE MOVE's objectives;
- Compatibility of the proposed activity with 117 Beach St facilities and programming.

Conditions of the residency:

- Artist to work with ART ON THE MOVE on public engagement connected to the project;
- Artist is responsible for installation, invigilation and removal of exhibited work and the return of the space to its original condition.
